Frequently Asked Questions

How do I find the list of classes online?

- 1. Visit web.gmc.cc.ga.us
- 2. Click Academics
- 3. Choose Classes Offered
- 4. Select Augusta for on-campus classes, and select DLC Online for online classes.
- 5. Make sure to select the correct term

How do I find out what else I need to graduate?

- 1. Go to the section on GMC Online called "Web Advisor"
- 2. Click on Academic Profile
- 3. Click on Program Evaluation

*****You can also see what you would need if you changed your major.

How to find your schedule:

- 1. Go to the section called "Web Advisor"
- 2. Click on the Academic Profile
- 3. Then click on My Class Schedule
- 4. Select the term from the dropdown menu

How to find your transcript:

- 1. Go to the section called "Web Advisor"
- 2. Click on the Academic Profile
- 3. Then click on the transcript

How to find your GPA:

- 1. Go to the section called "Web Advisor"
- 2. Click on the Academic Profile
- 3. Then click on GPA
- 4. Select the term from the dropdown menu

How can I find out what will transfer to another school?

- 1. Utilize GAcollege411.org (enter the classes you've taken at GMC and the system will help you determine what will transfer to other schools).
- 2. Do an internet search for "Transfer Equivalency Guide" for your school of choice.
- 3. Contact the admissions office for your school of choice and speak with the transfer representative.

How many classes do I have to take to get my GPA up? What grade do I have to get in a certain class to get my GPA up?

Where do I find the track sheet for my major?

- 1. Go to gmc.edu
- 2. Click on Academics
- 3. Click on Advising Center
- 4. Select Milledgeville Campus
- 5. Select Degree Requirements 2014
- 6. The top section is AS (Associate of Science), the middle section is AA (Associate of Arts), and the bottom is AAS (Associate of Applied Science).

How much longer do I have before I can graduate?

- 1. Count the classes that you need (see How do I find out what else I need to graduate?)
- 2. Determine how many classes you will take each quarter (full time is 12 or more credits, usually 3 classes).
- 3. Divide the number of classes needed by the number of classes taken each quarter.
- 4. For example, 15 classes are needed, you are taking 3 classes each term:

15 classes needed

= 5 terms

3 classes taken per term

5. Count five terms from the current term and you will know when you will graduate.
