

2010 Post Graduate Survey Report

Gwynedd-Mercy College: Career Services

Summary:

Overall more than 69 percent of the 2010 graduates are employed either full-time or part-time. Around 82 percent of graduates said their current employment is moderate to highly related to their major and degree. Additionally, almost 28 percent are attending graduate or professional school. Overall 96.7 percent of the 2010 graduating class are either employed full-time, part-time or attend graduate school.

Survey Method:

Graduate survey data was collected three times for each of the graduating classes (May, August and December). Approximately 2-3 months following each of the graduating classes, emails and phone calls were conducted. Students were emailed the survey link (Survey Monkey) and then follow up phone calls were made to those who didn't complete the online survey.

Total 2010 graduates: 764 **Responses:** 272 **Response rate:** 36%
