CAREER ASSESSMENT INSTRUMENTS

If you're unsure of the major or career that's right for you, or if you just want to confirm your decisions, consider taking an assessment. These self-assessments along with other additional major choice resources will help you discover what careers correspond to various majors. All of these resources can help you make a more informed choice when selecting a major or career path. Here are some examples of assessments Career Services offers:

Self-Directed Search - Compare your self-assessed abilities and interests with a variety of occupational groups. Must be taken in Career Services.

MBTI (Myers Briggs Type Indicator) - Assess your psychological type as an explanation to your personality. The MBTI is used in self-understanding and development; career exploration, counseling, and leadership development.
