



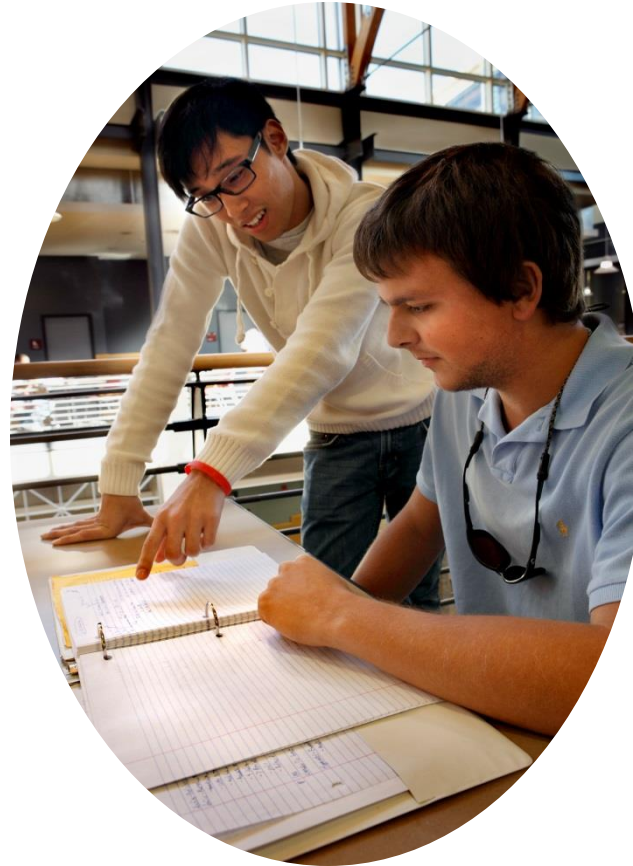

GMC Milledgeville Campus

- ▶ Enrollments increased by approximately 6% over the last year. Growing our enrollments to 1,780 students.
- ▶ Graduation rates have increased by approximately 10% with a total of 263 graduates.
- ▶ 37% of students attending the Milledgeville Campus are Baldwin County Residents
- ▶ Top three programs of study:
 - ▶ A.S. General Studies
 - ▶ A.S. Pre-Nursing
 - ▶ A.S. Business Administration



GMC Milledgeville Campus

Dual Enrollment/ Move On When Ready Program

- ▶ Milledgeville campus currently has 252 dual enrollment students. This is a 180% increase over the last year.
- ▶ 68% of dual enrollment students are residents of Baldwin County. Majority of which come from Baldwin County High School and GMC Prep.
- ▶ Dual enrollment offers students the opportunity to graduate simultaneously with their associate degree and H.S. diploma.

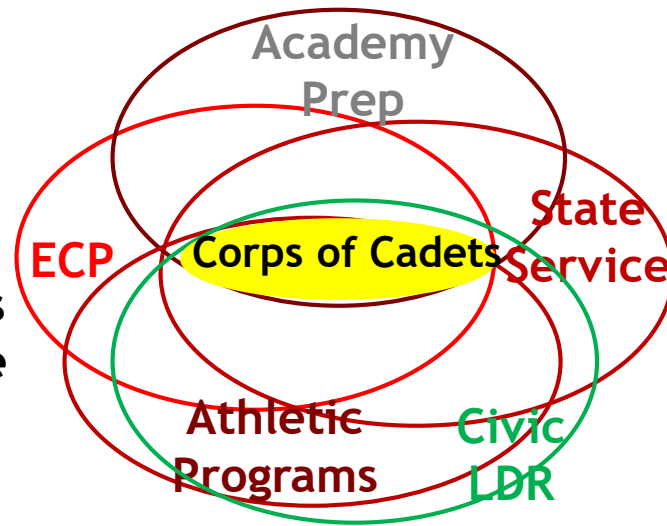

IMPACTS ON BALDWIN COUNTY

- ▶ Scholarship/Tuition Impact (Federal/State Aid—2.5 million/GMC 1.2 million)(Both merit & need based)
- ▶ Host Competition Impact (New events—Raider/All-service drill meet/JROTC Cadet Leadership Camp (14 high schools)



- ▶ Host Influencers Impact (New & Improved focus on cadet interactions with state/national influencers)



- ▶ Community Service Impact
 - ▶ Distinguished Order of the Servant Leader—cadet only (\$664k equivalent)
 - ▶ President's Higher Education Community Service Honor Roll



GMC Prep School

School Year 2015-2016

▶ Enrollment

- ▶ Public, Independent School serving grades 6 - 12
- ▶ Total Enrollment = 563 Students
- ▶ 50 % Male - 50% Female
- ▶ 73% Caucasian - 21% African American - 6% Other
- ▶ 73% Baldwin County Residents

▶ Scholarships

- ▶ \$458,719.65 was awarded to our students
- ▶ This met 35% of the identified financial need

▶ College Prep Academics

- ▶ 100% graduation rate for the 8th year in a row
- ▶ 61% of students in grades 11-12 were Dual Enrollment
- ▶ AP Pass rates continue to rise, exceeded the global pass rate in AP Biology, Language, and Statistics
- ▶ Average SAT and ACT scores have consistently exceeded released state and national averages



GMC Prep School

School Year 2015-2016

- ▶ Accolades
 - ▶ Athletics and Fine Arts have had a total of 11 State Championships and 1 National Championship since 2012
 - ▶ 5 of these titles came from this past school year - Raider Mixed National Championship, Varsity Softball, One Act, Literary, and Track
 - ▶ 92% of our student body participates in at least 1 extra-curricular activity
- ▶ Military/JROTC
 - ▶ 100% participation; our program is focused on developing leadership skills and a philosophy of civic duty within our cadets
- ▶ Community Service
 - ▶ We have showcased our community by hosting various athletic, fine arts, and military events that brought people to our community, such as:
 - ▶ JCLC Camp, Best Raider Competition, Region Literary, Softball, and One Act
