#### **DROP/ADD, LATE REGISTRATION, AND WITHDRAWAL POLICY:**

A student may drop or add a course during the drop/add period without academic penalty; however, there is a \$15 drop/add fee. The drop/add period is Mar. 20 - 22. A student may petition for a schedule correction Mar. 20 -22. After this time, students must follow the withdrawal procedure. No withdrawals will be processed in the final week of class.

Late Registration is Mar. 20 - 22. A \$25 Late Registration fee will apply.

*The student will be responsible for all academic charges and financial aid penalties relating to the course(s) from which the student withdraws or is withdrawn by the instructor.*
