Georgia Military College Prep School to Continue Remote Learning Through April 24, 2020

MILLEDGEVILLE, GA – In accordance with Governor Brian Kemp’s executive order of March 26, 2020, that public schools, K-12, remain closed for in-seat class instruction until April 24, 2020, students attending Georgia Military College Preparatory School will continue to learn in a remote setting until that date. During this time, we will reassess and make a decision for the remainder of the school year.

GMC will continue to support our students to the best of our ability, and to ensure their success. GMC is continuing to rigidly enforce hand sanitation and enhanced cleaning of every campus facility, along with social distancing in every department, to minimize the possibility of the presence of COVID-19.
