



2020-2021 GMC Facts in a Flash

Enrollment

- **Annual Unduplicated Headcount** (20F1-21SU) Decreased 14% from 14,828 students the previous year to 12,823 students this year. IPEDS Census data (July 1 to June 30) also decreased 13% from 16,351 to 14,240.
- **Annual FTE** (20F1-21SU) Decreased 19% from 8,380 the previous year to 6,792 this year.
- **Fall Enrollment** - Decreased 14% from 8,766 in Fall 2019 to 7,501 in the Fall 2020 term.

Student Success Measures

- **3-year Graduation Rate** (IPEDS) - Decreased from 32% (fall 2016 cohort) to 29% (fall 2017 cohort).
- **3-year Transfer-Out Rate** (IPEDS) – Increased from 24% (fall 2016 cohort) to 26% (fall 2017 cohort).
- **Fall-to-Fall Retention** (IPEDS) – Decreased from 53% (fall 2019 cohort) to 48% (fall 2020 cohort).
- **Graduates** (July 1 to June 30) – The total number of graduates increased 6% from 1880 in 2019-2020 to 1992 in 2020-2021. The number of graduates receiving associate degrees has increased 6% from 1,825 in 2019-2020 to 1,940 in 2020-2021. The number of graduates receiving bachelor of applied science degrees decreased 6% from 55 in 2019-2020 to 52 in 2020 -2021.
- **Degrees Awarded** (July 1 to June 30) The total number of degrees awarded increased 6% from 1,968 in 2019-2020 to 2,091 in 2020-2021.

College Demographics

- **Gender** (20F1-21SU) - The student body consists of 64% women and 36% men.
- **Ethnicity/Race** (20F1-21SU) - The GMC student body for those reporting ethnicity and race consists of:
 - 57% All Minority Students (IPEDS Census enrollments is 56% minority): 43% Black/African American, 8% Hispanic, 6% Other Minorities
- **Dual Enrollment** (20F1-21SU) - The number of dual enrollment students have decreased by 27% from 4,414 in 2019-2020 to 3,476 in 2020-2021. This program has also decreased the number of students in the “under 18” age range 22% from 3,111 in 2019-2020 to 2,550 in 2020-2021. The “under 18” age range comprises 20% of the student population.
- **Age** (20F1-21SU) - Majority of GMC students are between the ages of “18 and 24” (53%). GMC also has 21% of its students aged “25 to 39 years old” and 6% of its students aged “40 years and older.”
- **Student Type** (20F1-21SU) - The GMC student body is 98% commuter students along with 2% from the Cadet Corps. The GMC student body includes 7% Military Affiliated students.
- **International** (20F1-21SU) - The number of Non-Resident Aliens has decreased by 26% from 49 in 2019-2020 to 39 students in 2020-2021.
- **Fully Online** - (20FA) 42% of GMC students in the 2020 Fall Term enrolled fully online. Fully Online Student enrollment increased 30% from 2,456 in Fall 2019 to 3,186 in Fall 2020.
