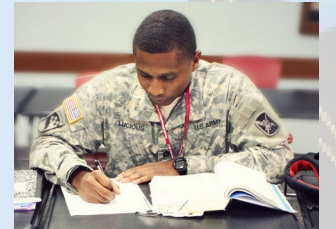
OPEN ENROLLMENT

GMC TRANSFER/ARTICULATION AGREEMENTS

GMC is Accredited by SACSCOC

(Southern Association of Colleges and Schools Commission on Colleges) to award Associate and select Bachelor of Applied Science degrees. Courses successfully completed at GMC are accepted for transfer credit at colleges and universities across the country.

What is a Transfer Agreement?

Also known as an articulation agreement, a transfer agreement is a formal partnership between two academic institutions that provides a formalized pathway for student transfer. GMC currently has 52 transfer agreements with four-year institutions across the state and beyond.

What do GMC's Transfer Agreements mean for you?

GMC's transfer agreements mean that most, if not all, of the coursework you take at GMC is guaranteed to transfer to those four-year institutions that GMC has agreements with. Some even include guaranteed admission to the institution, though some programs of study may have additional admission requirements.

PAYING FOR COLLEGE

GRANTS

Grants do not have to be repaid. Apply at studentaid.gov.
Georgia residents may be eligible for the Georgia Tuition Equalization Grant (GTEG),
apply at GAFutures.org.

LOANS

Most federal education loans have low fixed interest rates determined by the federal government. Generally, no payments are required until after the student leaves school or graduates. Banks and lending institutions also provide private low-interest loans for college.

FEDERAL WORK STUDY

This program allows students to work at the college while earning money for books, supplies, and other expenses. Students must qualify under federal guidelines.

MILITARY EDUCATION BENEFITS

Many of our students use military education benefits as active duty soldiers, military spouses, military dependents, or veterans. We accept active duty tuition assistance or veteran tuition assistance, to help pay for college.

SCHOLARSHIPS

Academic scholarships are awarded throughout the year at the local campus. Scholarships are another form of gift aid which does not have to be repaid.

DISCOUNTS

GMC offers senior citizens a tuition discount for students 62 or older.
Tuition discounts are also available for members of the Peace Officer's Association.

ADMISSIONS

What Type of Student Am I?

Dual Enrollment students can earn college credits while attending a Georgia high school or homeschool. The minimum GPA requirement is 2.5; must be a high school junior or senior. No entrance testing is required, but PSAT, SAT, or ACT scores can be provided to support placement.

First Time Freshman students must provide an official high school or GED transcript to demonstrate graduation. Homeschool graduates must have the transcript certified by a notary public. No minimum GPA is required; no entrance testing is required, but PSAT, SAT, or ACT scores can be provided to support placement.

International students are welcomed to attend GMC. Admissions requirements can be found online at gmc.edu/international-students/.

Transfer students must provide official transcripts from high school or GED, and from each college attended. No minimum GPA is required from the high school or previous college to gain acceptance. No entrance testing is required, but PSAT, SAT, or ACT scores can be provided to support placement.

Transient students who wish to take specific courses at Georgia Military College may do so with permission from their home institution. An official transient permission letter is required to enroll.

Non-Degree seeking students who wish to attend for personal enrichment are welcomed. No transcripts are required unless demonstrating a prerequisite has been satisfied for the course desired. Non-Degree seeking students cannot use any Financial Aid to pay tuition.

How Do I Become A Student?

Step 1

Submit an application on www.gmc.edu and request transcripts.

Step 2

Determine how you will pay for class. Apply for necessary financial aid at FAFSA.gov and GAFutures.org.

Step 3

Attend orientation, register for classes, log into the GMC Student Portal and obtain course materials.
