



## Student Right to Know Athlete Report, 2024

Georgia Military College offers a liberal-arts based, two-year curriculum designed to support student attainment of an associate degree and prepares students for transfer to four-year colleges and universities. Students with an associate of applied science degree are offered a curriculum designed to support attainment of a Bachelor of Applied Science degree. For selected college students who enroll in the Reserve Officer Training Corps (ROTC) and preparatory school students in the Junior ROTC program, GMC includes a military training and education component.

Federal Student Right-to-Know regulations call for colleges and universities to report certain information about the characteristics of their student-athletes who receive athletically-related student aid.



Since Georgia Military College offers athletically-related student aid, it must, according to Student Right-to-Know regulations, provide a report on enrollment, graduation, and transfer-out rates. To satisfy this federal requirement, this report includes the graduation and transfer rates for student-athletes, broken down by gender, race/ethnicity, and sport. However, if a category of students contains five or fewer students, the institution (according to federal regulations) need not disclose information in that category (in order to not personally identify students). Due to the small size of some of Georgia Military College's athletic programs, it is often the case that categories will contain five or fewer students. In categories where this is the case, "NR" (Not Reported) will be listed instead. The numbers displayed below for our student athletes represent only the individuals receiving athletically-related scholarships.

Graduation and transfer-out rates are based on degree completion or transfer of full-time, first-time, degree-seeking students within “150% of normal time,” which for a two-year degree would be three years. The rates do not include those who may have taken longer than three years to graduate or transfer. Overall success rates are calculated by combining the graduation and transfer rates of the students in the below cohorts.

All data in the below tables are as of March 2024.
