ROTC Requirements and Application

READ ALL BEFORE STARTING ON APPLICATION

The Army Requires a large amount of paperwork, this can be tedious, but not difficult. Once this is received, will communicate on completing the full application.

Requirements:

-US Citizen

-Age of 17 or older to contract, there is a maximum age (call or email)

-High School graduate or established college GPA

-Be Military Science III Qualified (Army Guard/Reserve, Prior Service, attend ROTC Basic Camp

-Academic Requirements – Scholarship:

2.5+ GPA required to compete for an ROTC Scholarship based on 4.0 system and Unweighted, (GED = 2.5 GPA). Provide SAT/ACT score. On GPA, once you establish a College GPA that is what we have to use for review.

-Academic Requirements – Non Scholarship (student pays full cost for college):

2.0+ GPA minimum to be in the program, based on 4.0 system and Unweighted.

If you have established a full term College GPA of a 2.5 or higher, then an SAT or ACT is not required, unless going to SMP (see below). **All of our Scholarship student are required to SMP.**

-Meet physical standards (Meet Army Height/Weight Standards and pass the Army Physical Fitness Test)

-Meet Medical Standards

Certain Medical Conditions are not waivable for the ROTC Program.

-All Legal issues must receive an approved waiver. All legal issues must be disclosed, regardless of status.

-ASVAB. Not required for initial application, but required for contracting.

-No more than three dependents

-There is an age limit, contact us to discuss

-Must accept a commission in the U.S. Army Reserve, or U.S. Army National Guard

-Be accepted by the college (The College Admissions Process is Separate from the ROTC Application)

Medical Issues: Not a doctor nor are we the one that would make the decision on a medical qualification or waivers. There are conditions that can keep a student out of the military (for all services, enlisted and officer) and some medications will require the student to be off of them for a year before a waiver is processed. The reason I bring this up is that every year we have students wanting to be in the Army then find out they cannot due to a medical issue, ending up

with a very disappointed student. Contact us if you have questions.

National Guard vs Army Reserves: For all of the students on ROTC scholarship to GMC, you have to be in the Guard or Reserves. All students are in the Simultaneous Membership Program, which is in the Guard/Reserves and in ROTC, so what unit you are assigned to has no impact on your status. If not completed, recommend you take the ASVAB and minimum score is 31.

The Army ROTC Scholarship will pay for Tuition/Fees/Books **OR** Room/Board, **BUT NOT BOTH**. Many Schools require the student to pay upfront regardless if they have an Army ROTC Scholarship, GMC has a process in place which ensures they receive payment for school. The student has basically three options: One being the student completes the FAFSA process putting a loan in place; two the student pays the school for the first term (tuition/fees/books/room/board); third is not attend GMC. Also the students have to pay for Uniforms and Books prior to the start of school, so be prepared to make a payment to the school regardless if you are a scholarship student or not.

ROTC Scholarships are initially an offer, not actual money for the scholarship. Once the student become qualified (Medically Qualified and pass the fitness test-ACFT) upon starting college, then the student can contract, which is when the scholarship actually become money.

The FAFSA is an annual requirement and available online at www.fafsa.ed.gov

Please check with GMC's financial aid office to verify your status. You must complete the FAFSA process before you are eligible to move into the barracks. If this process is not complete, you may be required to postpone your enrollment.

Students who meet all requirements by the end of the term will be reimbursed for tuition/fees/books. Uniforms are later reimbursed through commutation. Students who do not meet requirements by the end of the term are responsible for the cost of that term.
